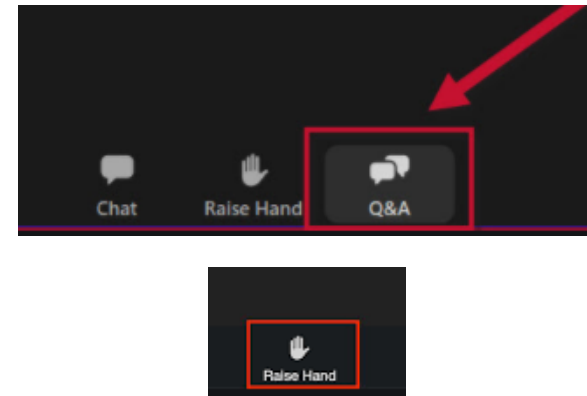

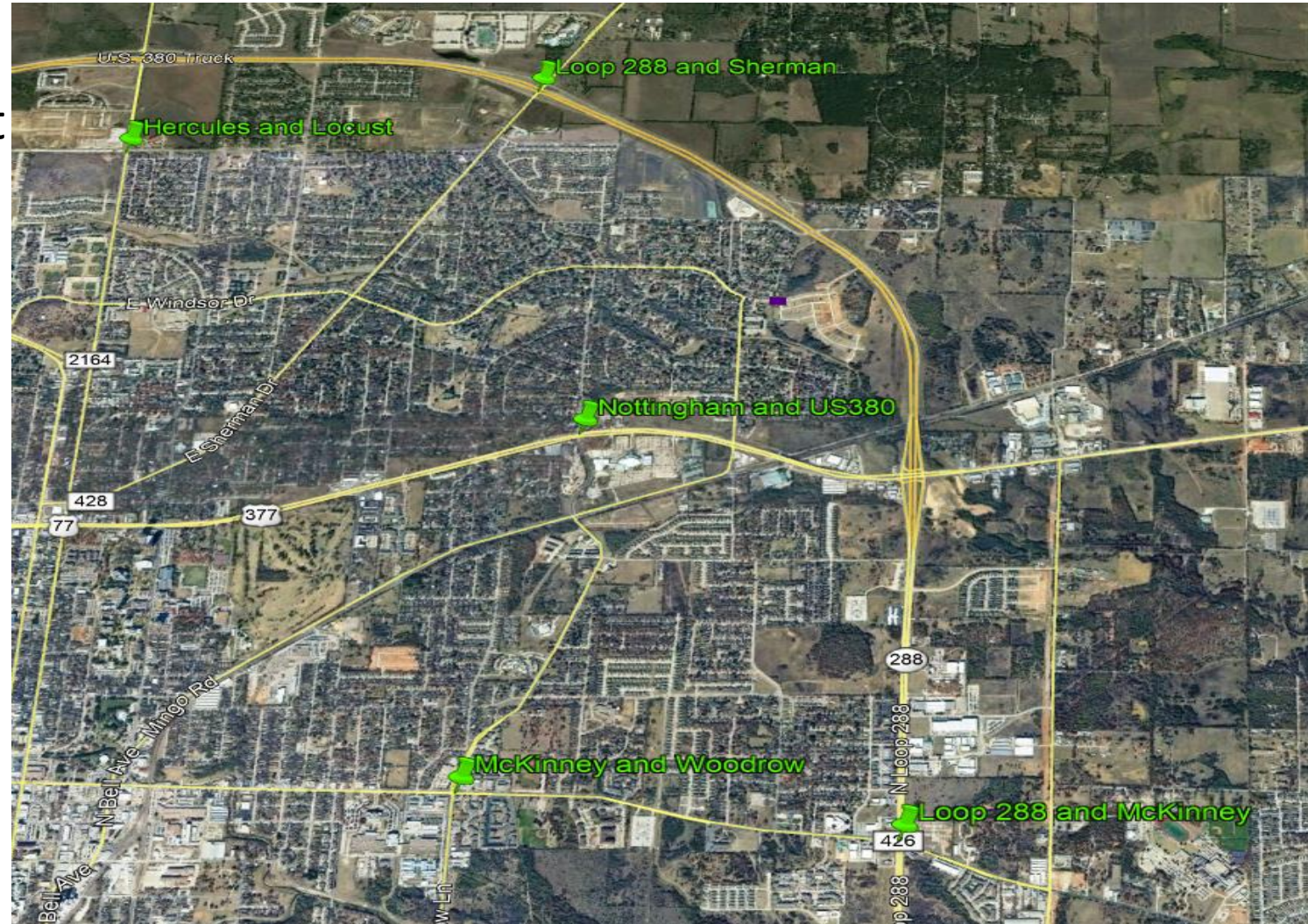

- Loop 288 and Sherman
- Hercules and Locust
- Nottingham and US 380



Current Project Timeline*

- **Construction Schedule**

- McKinney and Woodrow: Mid April – Mid June
- Loop 288 and McKinney: Early May - Late July
- Loop 288 and Sherman: Early April – Early June
- Hercules and Locust: Early April – Early June
- Nottingham and US 380 (University): Early May – Late July

- **Construction Completion**

- To be completed in Quarter 3 of calendar year 2021
