Committee direction was to update the budgeted project funds for artist proposals guidelines as follows:

- Have a threshold amount for each art piece based on the project artist budget.
- Requests for qualifications (RFQ) for artist budgets greater than eighty-thousand dollars is a threshold amount for paying an artist stipend for submitting a proposal.
- The PAC may select prequalified artists to a short list of two or three artists to develop proposals. Each artist may receive a stipend for developing and presenting their proposal. The winning proposal stipend would go toward the overall compensation to the artist.
- Calls for proposals below the threshold amount would not generally be eligible for a stipend unless the nature of the project would make generating a proposal costly for the artist.
- E. PAC21-022 Receive a report, hold a discussion, and give staff direction regarding the Trails Concept Map for future identification, renovation, and expansion of facilities and trails.

The item was presented, and discussion followed.

Following discussion, there was no direction provided as the item was for presentation purposes.

F. PAC21-023 Receive a report, hold a discussion, and give staff direction regarding the Fire Station 3 sculpture.
