2. CONSENT AGENDA:

A. Consider a request by Allegiance Hillview, L.P. for approval of a Conveyance Plat of Lot 3, Block 1, Rayzor Ranch South. The approximately 4.52-acre site is generally located on the west side of Bonnie Brae Street between Crescent Street and Linden Street in the City of Denton, Denton County, Texas. (CV18-0001, Rayzor Ranch East Tracts 8 & 9, Hayley Zagurski).

B. Consider a request by Allegiance Hillview, L.P. for approval of a Conveyance Plat of Lot 4, Block 1, Rayzor Ranch South. The approximately 6.55-acre site is generally located 288 feet west of Bonnie Brae Street on the south side of a future extension of Linden Street in the City of Denton, Denton County, Texas. (CV18-0002, Rayzor Ranch East Tracts14, Hayley Zagurski).

C. Consider a request by Justin Moeller with Allison Engineering Group representing Denton Justice Plaza for approval of a Final Plat of the Justice Plaza Addition. The approximately 6.72 acre site is generally located on the northeast corner of the intersection of East McKinney Avenue and Jannie Street, in the City of Denton, Denton County, Texas. (FP18-0004, Justice Plaza Addition, Cindy Jackson).

3. ITEMS FOR INDIVIDUAL CONSIDERATION:

A. Consider a request by Rayzor Investments, Ltd. for approval of a final plat of Retreat Addition, Block A, Lot 1. The approximately 25.13-acre site is generally located at the southeast corner of the future intersection of Precision Drive and West Oak Street in the City of Denton, Denton County, Texas. (FP18-0006, Retreat at Denton, Hayley Zagurski).

Hayley Zagurski, Senior Planner, presented this request. The applicant was present but did not wish to speak. Staff recommends approval of the request.

Commissioner Beck stated he will be voting against this request as he is opposed to the zoning.

Commissioner Margie Ellis motioned, Commissioner Alfredo Sanchez seconded to approve this request. **Motion approved** (5-1). Commissioner Alfredo Sanchez "aye", Commissioner Andrew Rozell "aye", Chair Jim Strange "aye", Commissioner Margie Ellis "aye", and Commissioner Tim Smith "aye". Commissioner Larry Beck "nay".

4. PUBLIC HEARINGS:

 A. Hold a public hearing and consider making a recommendation to City Council regarding a request by Preston Alpha Investments LLC to zone approximately 73.47 acres to Neighborhood Residential 6 (NR-6) District. The property is generally located on the north of Long Road and west of FM 428/Sherman Drive in the City of Denton, Denton County, Texas. (Z17-0028, Stark Farms, Cindy Jackson). THIS ITEM HAS BEEN POSTPONED BY THE CITY.

This item has been postponed and will be renoticed.

B. Hold a public hearing and consider making a recommendation to City Council regarding a request by Marc DeGenaro representing Daniel Sobarames Hernandez for an initial zoning designation of Neighborhood Residential 2 (NR-2) District. The 1.00 acre site is generally located east of Masch Branch Road, along Miller Road, in the City of Denton, Denton County, Texas. (Z18-0007, Little Brook Estate, Cindy Jackson). THIS ITEM HAS BEEN POSTPONED AT THE REQUEST OF THE APPLICANT.

This item has been postponed and will be renoticed.

C. Hold a public hearing and consider making a recommendation to City Council regarding a request by the City of Denton for a zoning change from Downtown Residential 1 (DR-1) to a Downtown Commercial General (DC-G) District. The 1.33-acre site is generally located south of Underwood Street along Avenue A, in the City of Denton, Denton County, Texas. (Z18-0006b, Fire Station 3, Hayley Zagurski).

Chair Strange opened the Public Hearing. Hayley Zagurski, Senior Planner, presented this request. Staff sent out public hearing notices and received one response in opposition. Staff recommends approval of the request.

Commissioner Beck questioned if there will be ingress and egress flashing lights on the site. Zagurski stated that would be determined later in the process. Chair Strange questioned if the two properties would be platted into one lot in the future. Zagurski confirmed.

There was no one to speak, Chair Strange closed the Public Hearing.

Commissioner Larry Beck motioned, Commissioner Andrew Rozell seconded to approve the request. **Motion approved (6-0).** Commissioner Alfredo Sanchez "aye", Commissioner Larry Beck "aye", Commissioner Andrew Rozell "aye", Chair Jim Strange "aye", Commissioner Margie Ellis "aye", and Commissioner Tim Smith "aye".

D. Hold a public hearing and consider a request by Marker Stone Realty Partners II

LLC for approval of a Final Replat of Beall Way Addition; being a residential replat
of a part of La Hacienda Heights Phase I and previously unplatted land. The

approximately 54.05-acre property is generally located west of North Locust Street in between Hercules Lane and Beall Street in the City of Denton, Denton County, Texas. This item has been continued from the May 9, 2018 Planning and Zoning Commission meeting. (FR17-0024, Beall Way Addition, Hayley Zagurski).

Chair Strange recused himself from this agenda item as he has a conflict of interest. Vice-Chair Rozell served as Chair. Vice-Chair Rozell opened the Public Hearing. Hayley Zagurski, Senior Planner, presented this request. The applicant held a neighborhood meeting, staff recommends approval of the request based on one condition. The applicant is present.

Lee Allison, Applicant, Allison Engineering Group, 2415 N. Elm Street, Denton, Texas, provided a brief presentation including history on the project and the land. He stated David Marks is also present.

There was no one else to speak, Vice-Chair Rozell closed the Public Hearing.

Commissioner Tim Smith motioned, Commissioner Margie Ellis seconded to approve this request, based on the following staff condition: 1. Civil engineering construction plans for all public infrastructure necessary to serve the proposed development must be approved before the plat is filed. If any utility easement locations need to be modified as a result of the final civil engineering construction plans, DRC approval shall be required prior to filing. **Motion approved (5-0-1).** Commissioner Alfredo Sanchez "aye", Commissioner Larry Beck "aye", Commissioner Andrew Rozell "aye", Commissioner Margie Ellis "aye", and Commissioner Tim Smith "aye". Chair Jim Strange recused.
