WORK SESSION

2. PUBLIC HEARINGS

This notice authorizes the Planning and Zoning Commission to recommend and City Council to approve a different zoning district which is equivalent to or more restrictive than that which is requested by the applicant, as the different district may not have a maximum structure height, floor area ratio, or density that is higher than the one requested or be nonresidential when the request is for a residential use or vice versa. The different zoning district must be deemed consistent with the Comprehensive Plan and the Future Land Use Plan.

- A. <u>SE18-0001</u> Hold a public hearing and consider making a recommendation to City Council regarding a request by Cli Max Enterprises for the expansion of the People's Funeral Home building and parking lot onto adjoining lots. The 0.64-acre site is generally located on the south side of East Mulberry Street, approximately 50 feet west of Wood Street, in the City of Denton, Denton County, Texas. (SE18-0001, People's Funeral Home Expansion, Hayley Zagurski). THIS ITEM HAS BEEN WITHDRAWN.
- **B.** <u>Z17-0028b</u> Hold a public hearing and consider making a recommendation to City Council regarding a request by Preston Alpha Investments LLC to zone approximately 73.47 acres to Neighborhood Residential 6 (NR-6) District. The property is generally located on the

north side of Long Road and west of FM 428/Sherman Drive in the City of Denton, Denton County, Texas. (Z17-0028, Stark Farms, Cindy Jackson).
