McKinney Street, Denton, Texas at which the following items will be considered:

The Public Utilities Board (PUB) will convene in a Closed Meeting to consider specific items when these items are listed below under the Closed Meeting section of this agenda. When items for consideration are not listed under the Closed Meeting section of the agenda, the PUB will not conduct a Closed Meeting and will immediately convene its open meeting. The PUB reserves the right to adjourn into a Closed Meeting on any item on its open meeting agenda consistent with Chapter 551 of the Texas Government Code, as amended, or as otherwise allowed by law.

## **CLOSED MEETING**

A. <u>PUB15-029</u> Deliberations regarding Real Property - Under Texas Government Code Section 551.072; Consultation with Attorneys - Under Texas Government Code Section 551.071.

Receive information from staff, discuss, deliberate, and provide staff with direction regarding the potential acquisition of real property interests located east of Loop 288 and Spencer Rd. to Pockrus Page Rd. and HWY I-35E; where discussions had, deliberation, and direction given, by the Denton City Council in an open meeting would have a detrimental effect on the position of the governmental body in negotiations with a third party. with the City's attorneys regarding legal issues associated with the acquisition of the real property interests described above; discussion of these legal matters in an open meeting would conflict with the duty of the City's attorneys to the City of Denton and the Denton Public Utilities Board under the Texas Disciplinary Rules of Professional Conduct of the State Bar of Texas, or would jeopardize the City's legal position in any administrative proceeding or potential litigation. C. <u>PUB15-082</u> CONSULTATION WITH ATTORNEYS - Under Texas Government Code, Sec. 551.071.

Consult with the City's attorneys regarding the present status of settlement negotiations regarding pending litigation styled: City of Denton, Texas v. NRG Power Marketing, LLC, Cause No. 15-01404-16, now pending in the 16th Judicial District Court of Denton County, Texas, and discuss, deliberate and provide the City's attorneys with direction and any recommendations regarding such legal matter. A public discussion of this legal matter would conflict with the duty of the City's Attorneys to the City Council under the Texas Disciplinary Rules of Professional Conduct of the State Bar of Texas.

**D.** <u>PUB15-087</u> CONSULTATION WITH ATTORNEYS - Under Texas Government Code, Sec. 551.071.

Consult with the City's attorneys about Verizon Southwest, Inc.'s unpaid pole attachment fees including the status of settlement negotiations, potential litigation, and related issues. A public discussion of this legal matter would conflict with the duty of the City's Attorneys to the City Council under the Texas Disciplinary Rules of Professional Conduct of the State Bar of Texas.
