#### **1. PUBLIC HEARINGS**

A. <u>PUB17-092</u> Hold a public hearing and consider recommending that the City Council adopt a resolution regarding the proposed site for construction, expansion, and use of the electric power transmission line located in an area bounded by Bernard Street (western boundary), Eagle Drive (northern boundary), S. Locust Street and W. Collins Street (eastern boundary), and W. Collins Street (southern boundary), lying within the City of Denton, Denton County, Texas; as part of Denton Municipal Electric's service territory. [Eagle to Locust TM Line]

Consultation with the City's attorneys regarding legal issues associated with the above matters where a public discussion of these legal matters would conflict with the duty of the City's attorneys to the City of Denton and the Denton City Council under the Texas Disciplinary Rules of Professional Conduct of the State Bar of Texas, or would jeopardize the City's legal position in any administrative proceeding or potential litigation.

THE PUBLIC UTILITIES BOARD RESERVES THE RIGHT TO ADJOURN INTO A CLOSED MEETING OR EXECUTIVE SESSION AS AUTHORIZED BY TEX. GOV'T. CODE, §551.001, ET SEQ. (THE TEXAS OPEN MEETINGS ACT) ON ANY ITEM ON ITS OPEN MEETING AGENDA OR TO RECONVENE IN A CONTINUATION OF THE CLOSED MEETING ON THE CLOSED MEETING ITEMS NOTED ABOVE, IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE OPEN MEETINGS ACT, INCLUDING, WITHOUT LIMITATION §551.071-551.086 OF TEXAS THE TEXAS OPEN MEETINGS ACT.
