A. ID 22-036 Receive a report, hold a discussion, and give staff direction regarding the Denton 2040 Comprehensive Plan Update and the Draft 2022 Mobility Plan for the City of Denton. [Council Priority; Estimated Presentation/Discussion Time: 4 hours]

The item was presented and discussion followed.

- Use of the Vision Statement as presented, including the Land Preservation Map and FLUM changes, further land planning and detailed analysis, and staff to schedule future discussion April 5, 2022, addition of the Master Planned Communities to the Preferred Growth Map;
- As it relates to the ETJ area, the Plan will include the Option #2 map presented showing the potential MUDs;
- Staff will evaluate the DDC and adopt additional provisions as it relates to supporting infill and redevelopment; and
- Additional action items to be included in the Plan as related to wildlife corridors, protecting green space around major watersheds, connectivity of green space, parks and trails, ESAs and riparian areas, and identifying parcels with tree canopy greater than 30%.

City Council consensus was also reached on no further discussion being needed on the Plans as reflected on the posted agenda for its February 15, 2022 meeting.
