




# **Project Overview**

## Project Scope:

 Construction for this project will include wastewater capacity upgrades to meet current and future demands.

## **Project Extents:**

Project will start near Fireside Lane and move west along Windsor Drive ending near Bonnie Brae.





## **Project Schedule and Budget**

### Schedule:

- Contract time will begin on April 11th, 2022
- The project schedule is a substantial completion within 195 calendar days from start of contract
  \*Completion timeline is weather dependent\*

## Budget:

Cost for this project is \$1.2 million



## What to Expect During Construction

- Access to homes in active construction areas
  - > Contractor will work with residents for driveway access and safe routes in and out of the neighborhood during construction
- Road closures and detours
  - > Prior notice to residents of upcoming temporary street closures
  - > Clear detour route signage will be posted during closures
