



Project Scope

Improve North Texas Blvd from I-35E Service Road to Highland Park, matching up alignment to the existing North Texas Boulevard overpass and improving UNT events traffic flow while maintaining the neighborhood feel of the area from Highland Park/Underwood.

This project is funded by a \$2M grant from TxDOT/North Central Texas Council of Governments (NCTCOG)







Project Details

This project will:

- Provide dedicated right lane into stadium drive
- Provide dedicated left, straight and right turn lanes from North Texas Blvd to 35-E
- ✓ Add medians
- ✓ Add street lighting
- Provide sidewalk connectivity & crosswalks
- Align intersection with newly constructed TxDOT overpass
- ✓ Improve drainage
- Maintain current Highland
 Park/Underwood intersection
 conditions
