Staff are directed to no longer allow the use of HOT funds for expenses related to virtual events based on the State's requirements for the use of funds. The Committee directed the continued allowance of Sponsorship funds for expenses related to virtual events. Staff are directed to continually monitor changes in special events and provide updates to the Committee for further consideration of use of funding as needed.

E. <u>CPC22-006</u> Receive a report, hold a discussion, and give staff direction regarding the Hotel Occupancy Tax Program Year 2023 for FY 2022-23.

F. <u>CPC22-007</u> Receive a report, hold a discussion, and give staff direction regarding the Sponsorship Program and Parks and Recreation Department's Co-Sponsorship Program for FY 2022-23.

Staff were directed to remove the requirement stating special events must be held on public property and to limit in-kind support of assessed park fees and facility use fees to 50%.
