

Schedule

Improve North Texas Blvd from I-35E Service Road to Highland Park, matching up alignment to the existing North Texas Boulevard overpass and improving UNT events traffic flow while maintaining the neighborhood feel of the area from Highland Park/Underwood.

This project is funded by a \$2M grant from TxDOT/North Central Texas Council of Governments (NCTCOG)

April 2023:	-	Estimated Construction Completion






Details

This project will:

- ✓ Provide dedicated right lane into stadium drive
- ✓ Provide dedicated left, straight and right turn lanes from North Texas Blvd to 35-E
- ✓ Add medians
- ✓ Add street lighting
- Provide sidewalk connectivity & crosswalks
- Align intersection with newly constructed TxDOT overpass
- ✓ Improve drainage
- Maintain current Highland Park/Underwood intersection conditions





Expect

CONSTRUCTION PHASE 1

- Currently working on the drainage improvements
- Beginning the week of October 24th, North Texas Blvd will be oneway only heading toward Highland Park, away from I-35E.
- Two-way traffic to access the Stadium will be provided at every scheduled home football game. South of the stadium entrance, the road will remain one-way.
- Some full road closures MAY occur, most likely towards the end of phase 1 construction
- Message Boards will be updated with anticipated changes





Expect

CONSTRUCTION PHASE 2

- Apogee Stadium access road will be closed for the remainder of construction (after last home football game 11/26)
- One-way traffic towards I-35 will be implemented.
- Some full road closures MAY occur during this phase to complete the multiple islands and to construct the top course of paving
- Intermittent traffic control along service road will be restricted to short daily operations (traffic signal/striping work)
- Message Board will be updated with anticipated changes



Full road closures MAY occur during both Phases 1 & 2. When a full road closure is implemented, please look for:

- New Full Closure signs added to the existing sign locations
- Message board notifications
- All full lanes closures lasting longer than 48-hours are required to be posted in the City's road closure report posted each Friday for the following week: https://www.discussdenton.com/improvingdenton




