1. Work Session Reports

A. PZ22-274: Receive a report and hold a discussion regarding the updates to the Roadway Impact Fees.

City staff and Pete Kelly, Consultant, presented the report to the Commissioners, a discussion followed.

Following discussion, the Capital Improvement Advisory Committee (CIAC) consensus was to increase the Roadway Impact Fees from the existing fee adopted by City Council in 2016 to 50 percent of the maximum allowable fee and gradually increasing annually to 80 percent, to move forward with the proposed Land Use Assumption and Capital Improvement Plan included in the Roadway Impact Fee Study. The CIAC also requested Service Areas A, C, and D be evaluated to receive a stronger discount for commercial development in the future.
