Scope & Schedule

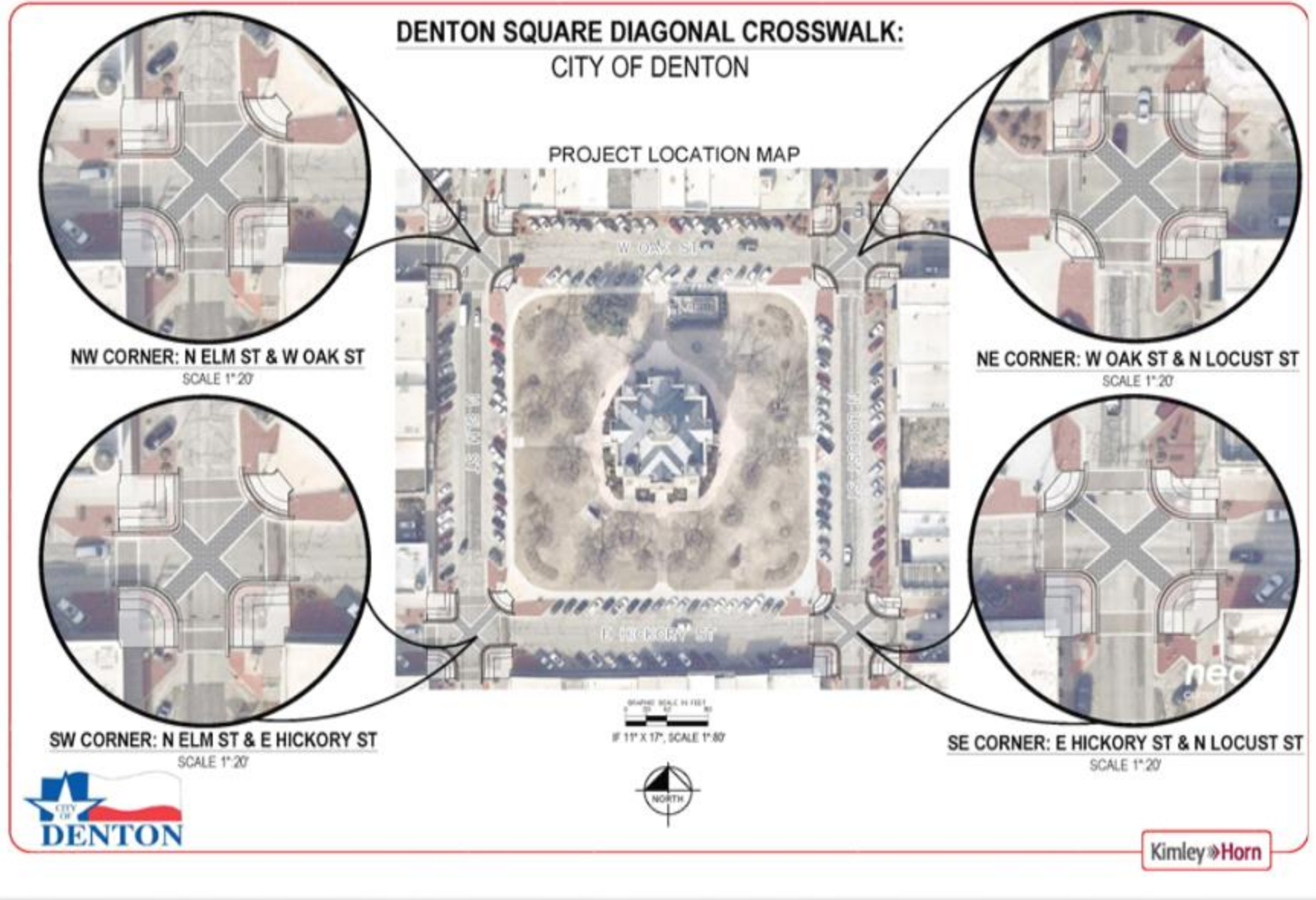
Installation of permanent diagonal crosswalks at the four intersections around the Courthouse on the Square.

Project Details

This project will:

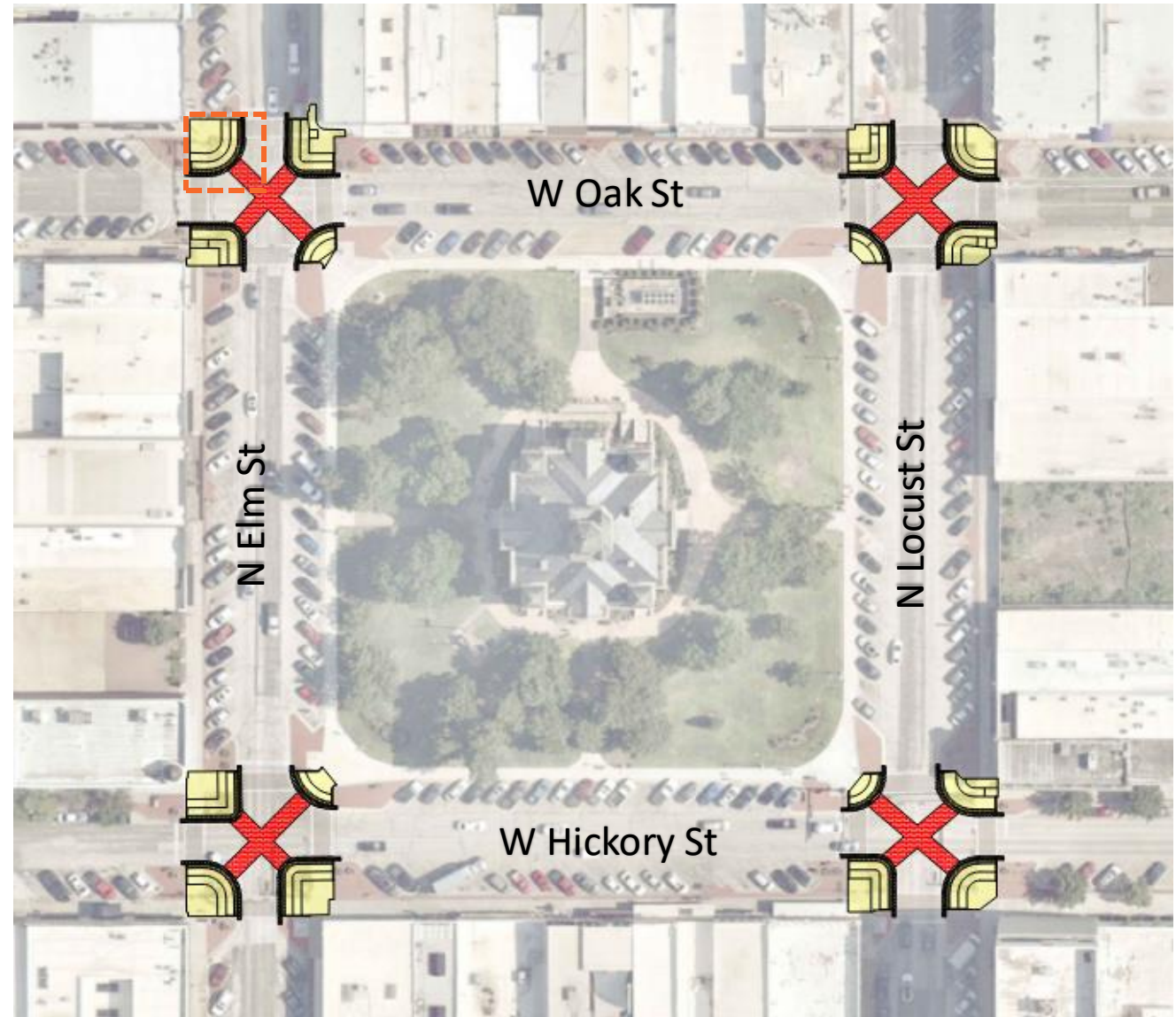
- ✓ Add stamped concrete diagonal crosswalks (color match existing crosswalks as close as possible)
- ✓ Add ramps at each corner
- ✓ Relocate ped buttons
- ✓ Update white striping of existing crosswalks and stop bars



What to Expect

CONSTRUCTION PHASING

- Construction will begin January 23 at the intersection of Oak and Elm (weather permitting)
- Crossings will be constructed one intersection at a time, one quarter at a time to maintain a continuous travel lane.
- Contractor will coordinate with business owners to maintain pedestrian access
- Pedestrian detour routes are anticipated
- Message Boards will be updated with anticipated changes
- Goal: One lane of traffic to remain open to provide access to businesses and parking
- Reality: Some full road closures and detours MAY occur during the construction of the diagonal crossings, especially during concrete delivery times

WHAT ARE THE CONTRACTORS WORKING HOURS?

When will the contractor start work in the morning – when will they stop?

- Standard working hours are Monday through Friday 7am to 4pm
(Per City Contract available working hours are 7am to 8pm)
- Weekend Work MAY Occur if warranted and per the City's contract
(Weekend Working Hours—Those hours between 8:00 a.m. and 8:30 p.m. on Saturday, and between 1:00 p.m. and 8:30 p.m. on Sunday or on a federal or state holiday observed by the City, as approved in advance by the City for performing Work.)

WHEN IS THE PROJECT GOING TO BE FINISHED?

The project is anticipated to be substantially complete and all lanes open to traffic by June 15, 2023. (weather permitting)

The goal is to complete ¼ of each intersection per week, approximately 1 month per intersection.

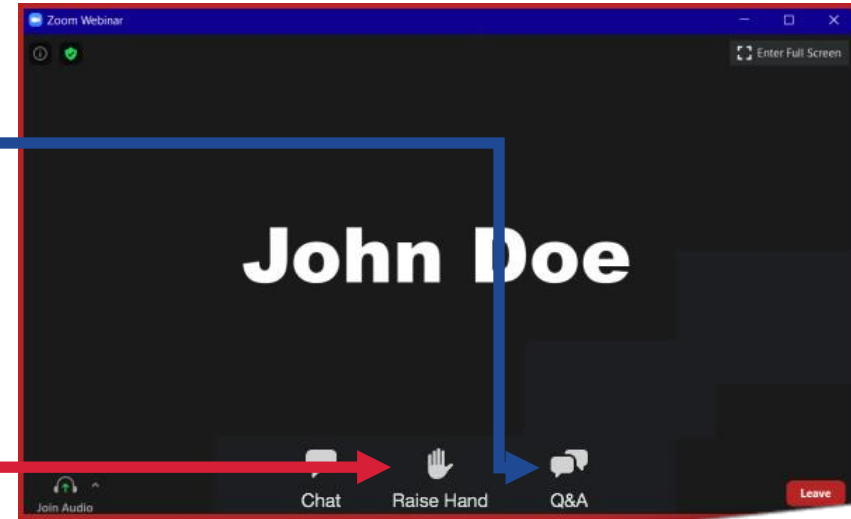
