Bekker updated them regarding Summer Reading Challenge. After the November book sale, they will just use the large area of their storage and the Library will use the office that was used for past book sale item storage. - Discovery Kits-Clear backpacks with learning and discovery activities available at all branches. They are for pre-school, elementary and teens; very popular; Checkout: 3 weeks
- Library Staff Honored for Saving a Citizen's Life

- Emily Fowler Central Library Staffing: Library Assistant II was hired--Laura Eleo Librarian Archivist position--hiring in process
- Library staff participating in SPARK: Igniting Leadership program-Kerry Montz and Greg Fowler accepted to participated; 9 month intensive program with mentoring to develop leadership skills and professional development
- Corinth card program--City of Corinth subsidizes accounts for Corinth residents; pays half of cost of annual card
- Library Master Plan-Request from 9 consultants for a master plan. Responses were limited. Quotes were significantly above budget. Looking to lower cost by taking on some of the work in-house.
