C. 25 Receive a report and hold a discussion regarding proposed City Initiated Zoning Change 26 Areas. Receive a report and hold a discussion regarding the 2019 Development Code and 27 D. 28 strategies or amending specific Sections of the Code. 29 Chair John Ryan motioned, Council member Keely Briggs seconded to approve the July 12, 30 2019 meeting minutes. Unanimous vote, no denials. Chair John Ryan sated motion carries. 31 32 33 Ron Menguita, Principal Planner, explained that on the August 20th public hearing two proposals 34 will be presented, they are code amendments for the 2019 Development Code to address both house bills and stop gap ordinances. Menguita explained for House Bill 2439 the intent for the 35 stop gap ordinances is to suspend the enforcement of any provisions or regulations standards 36 related to materials and provide procedures for appealing decisions. For House Bill 3767 as it 37 suspends any conflicting applications with regards to subdivisions and development. Menguita 38 mentioned planning is working on ordinances that will give the city the opportunity to address 39 40 both code amendments. Council member Keely Briggs, questioned what happens with projects 41 going through the process of being approved and currently haven't been approved. Will those projects be affected, and can the applicants stop and continue with the new procedures. Menguita 42 43 explained yes, that is what is anticipated but the city is prohibited from enforcing any building material from any point in time for anything being done as of September 1st. 44

Menguita presented a flow chart that explains procedures for House Bill 3167. The flow chart 1 explains the process of what applications will be required that primarily relate to platting. The 2 flow chart also explains the submittal process to staff and review time frames of each specific 3 application along with deadlines before any application is presented to Planning and Zoning 4 Commission. Scott McDonald, Director of Development Services, explained the fee process and 5 added due to staff helping throughout the entire pre-application process more staff will be needed 6 to meet deadlines. During the review process staff will meet with applicants, provide correct and 7 accurate feedback and present everything to P&Z. Staff is currently working through plans 8 associated to planning, flow chart and platting procedures that we hope will be beneficial to our 9 development community and make the pre-application process simple. 10 Committee and staff members discussed accessory dwelling and decided to have another work 11 session specifically on infill areas for duplexes. Menguita mentioned accessory dwellings need to be 12 reviewed to decide whether it will be part of an existing building and how addressing will be 13 14 resolved.
