REGULAR MEETING

- A. MC19-066 The Mobility Committee meeting minutes of August 13, 2019 were considered for approval. CM Briggs made a motion to approve and CM Ryan seconded. The minutes were approved by vote (3-0).
- B. MC19-067 Haley Salazar presented and update on the North Central Texas Council of Government's (NCTCOG) Policy Bundle Program. This item was for reporting / presentation purposes only.
- C. MC19-070 Marc Oliphant presented a report on the City bikeshare program, ridership statistics, and program oversight. This item was for information, status update and discussion only.
- D. MC19-072 Nicole Recker and Troy Raley shared updates on the DCTA services and upcoming changes, programs and events.

The presentation was made and all questions were addressed.

- E. MC19-073 John Polster from Innovative Transportation Solutions Incorporated presented the On-Systems Project Summary and a status update for:

The total value for this list of projects is \$2,280,911,124. Most of these have been funded or are in the pipeline to be funded within the next 18 to 24 months.

All questions presented were reviewed and addressed.

Following discussion, there was no direction provided as the item was for reporting purposes only.

- F. MC19-074** Brian Jahn presented a report on the implementation of an exclusive pedestrian phase in the traffic signal operations of the downtown intersections at Oak and Elm, Oak and Locust, Hickory and Elm, and Hickory and Locust as a pilot program for evaluation as a safety improvement for all modes of transportation in the downtown area.

This plan was previously presented to the Traffic Safety Commission and is schedule for presentation to City Council this afternoon. Due to the calendar and meeting order sequence, it will also be presented next week to the Committee on Persons with Disabilities for additional comments and potential approval.

Following the discussion, the consensus was to proceed with the presentation to Council today with the consideration of being contingent on approval of the Committee on Persons with Disabilities.



CONCLUDING ITEMS


