Consider recommending adoption of an ordinance of the City of Denton, a Texas home-rule municipal corporation, authorizing the approval of a second amendment to a Professional Services Agreement between the City of Denton and POWER Engineers, Inc., amending the contract approved by City Council on October 9, 2018, in the not-to-exceed amount of \$776,600; amended by Amendment 1 approved by the Purchasing Staff; said second amendment to provide services for CIP projects, where relay and control commissioning is required, for periodic NERC testing, meeting obligations of the Texas Municipal Power Agency (TMPA) Transmission Operator, Maintenance, and Construction Services Agreement; providing for the expenditure of funds therefor; and providing an effective date (File 6861 - providing for an additional second amendment expenditure amount not-to-exceed \$604,800, with the total contract amount not-to-exceed \$1,381,400).
