2 sign will be in the same place as the existing sign.

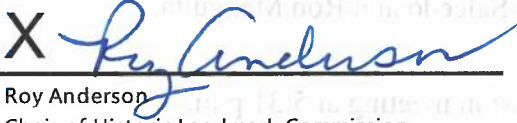
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4 Commissioner Linnie McAdams motioned to approved Item 2B. Commissioner Angela Stripling
