REGULAR MEETING

1. CONSENT AGENDA

- **A.** <u>PUB20-083</u> Consider recommending adoption of an ordinance of the City of Denton, a Texas home-rule municipal corporation, rejecting any and all competitive proposals under RFP 7227 for the supply and installation of Denton Energy Center (DEC) exhaust air silencers; and providing an effective date (RFP 7227).
- **B.** <u>PUB20-084</u> Consider recommending adoption of an ordinance of the City of Denton, a Texas homerule municipal corporation, authorizing the City Manager to execute a contract with FCx Performance Inc. dba Instrumentation Services, for predictive maintenance testing services for the Water Reclamation Department's treatment plant and lift stations; providing for the expenditure of funds therefor; and providing an effective date (RFP 7300 awarded to FCx Performance Inc. dba Instrumentation Services, for three (3) years, with the option for two (2) additional one (1) year extensions, in the total five (5) year not-to-exceed amount of \$118,200).
- C. <u>PUB20-085</u> Consider recommending adoption of an ordinance of the City of Denton, a Texas homerule municipal corporation, authorizing the City Manager, or his designee, to execute a contract with Holt Caterpillar Inc. through the Sourcewell Cooperative Purchasing Contract Number 032119, for the acquisition of one (1) New Caterpillar model D6XE Track Type Dozer for the Solid Waste/Landfill Department; authorizing the expenditure of funds therefor; and declaring an effective date (File 7376 awarded to Holt Caterpillar Inc., in the not-to-exceed amount of \$469,401.38).
- **D.** <u>PUB20-097</u> Consider recommending adoption of an ordinance of the City Council of the City of Denton, a Texas Home-rule Municipal Corporation, authorizing the City Manager, or his designee, to execute an Indemnity Escrow Agreement among and between the Texas Municipal Power Agency, the Cities of Bryan, Texas, Denton, Texas, Garland, Texas and Greenville, Texas regarding the establishment

of an escrow to fund TMPA's indemnity obligations pursuant to the joint operating agreement between the Cities and TMPA; and providing an effective date.

- **E.** <u>PUB20-102</u> Consider recommending adoption of an ordinance of the City of Denton, a Texas homerule municipal corporation, authorizing the City Manager, or his designee, to execute a contract with Tymco Inc., through the Houston-Galveston Area Council of Governments (H-GAC) Cooperative Purchasing Program Contract Number SW04-20, for the acquisition of one (1) Tymco model 600 Regenerative Air Sweeper for the Drainage Department; authorizing the expenditure of funds therefor; and declaring an effective date (File 7294 awarded to Tymco Inc. in the not-to-exceed amount of \$239,185).
- **F.** <u>PUB20-104</u> Consider recommending adoption of an ordinance of the City of Denton, a Texas homerule municipal corporation, authorizing the City Manager, or his designee, to execute a contract with Rush Truck Centers of Texas LP through the Buy Board Cooperative Purchasing Network Contract number 601-19, for the acquisition of one (1) 2020 Peterbilt model 348 truck chassis with hoist and two (2) emergency generators for the Water Reclamation Department; authorizing the expenditure of funds therefor; and declaring an effective date (File 7367 awarded to Rush Truck Centers of Texas LP, in the not to exceed amount of \$634,703.94).
- **G. PUB20-105** Consider recommending adoption of an ordinance of the City of Denton, a Texas homerule municipal corporation, authorizing the City Manager to execute a contract with Centricity GIS, for the continuation of the services for utility line locates for the Water Distribution Department, Wastewater Collections, Water Metering, and Denton Municipal Electric Department provided by Texas 811, which is the sole provider of these commodities and services, in accordance with Texas Local Government Code 252.022, which provides that procurement of commodities and services that are available from one source are exempt from competitive bidding, and if over \$50,000 shall be awarded by the governing body; and providing an effective date (File 7336 awarded to Centricity GIS, in the five (5) year not-to-exceed amount of \$300,000).

Board Member DeVinney pulled items A and D.

Board Member Bafford motioned to approve items B, C, E, F and G with a second by Board Member Russell. Vote 6-0.

DeVinney asked questions regarding item A. Stated she remembered when she first was on the Board that staff was working on different options to cut down the sound. What happened to the berm that was to be put in at the DEC to help with the noise and asked if there is any evidence that we will receive acceptable bids. Chris Lutrick answered the amount of noise reduction that you would get for the berm was not worth the cost. The landscaping and trees were added but the noise reduction berm is not a viable option. The RFP had to be extended two times and, in the end, there was only one bidder. There is a closed item session that will have more options. Board Member DeVinney motioned to approve with a second by Board Member Bafford. Vote 6-0.

DeVinney asked questions regarding item D. She asked if this escrow is a new thing for DME with TMPA and do we know what it will cost us. Smith Day answered the questions. This is not a new agreement, it was put together by several cities, and is already funded by TMPA for the amount of \$5,000,000. **Board Member Cheek motioned to approved with a second by Board Member Bafford. Vote 6-0.**

A. PUB20-076 - Consider approval of the minutes of May 11, 2020.

Board Member Bafford approved with a second by Board Member DeVinney. Vote 6-0.

B. <u>PUB20-101</u> - Consider recommending adoption of an ordinance of the City of Denton, a Texas homerule municipal corporation, authorizing the City Manager to execute a contract with JDK Associates, Inc., for the installation of a gravity retaining wall in the Brinker Substation; providing for the expenditure of funds therefor; and providing an effective date (RFP 7316 - awarded to JDK Associates, Inc., in the not-to-exceed amount of \$755,296.68).

Terry Naulty gave the presentation explaining the need of the wall to be installed at the Brinker Substation starting with the background. He then showed a print of the site and explained where the wall will be. There were a few questions by the Board Members.

Board Member DeVinney motioned to approve with a second by Board Member Bafford. Vote 6-0.

WORK SESSION

A. <u>PUB20-103</u> - Receive a report and hold a discussion regarding the 2019 Water Loss Audit Report.

Tyler Dawson gave this extensive comprehensive report. This is a regulatory report that is presented yearly. The formula for this is 'Authorized Consumption plus Apparent Losses plus Real Losses equals the Total Water Supplied'. The Water Audit Tree which is the categorized water use was shown and

explained. Real loss and apparent losses were explained and detailed. The cost of water loss was shown for real loss as well as apparent loss.

Staff has made a big improvement on how they determine how much water is lost during a leak or main break. The new leak detection system is called Zoom Scan.

There were a few questions by our Board Members.

CLOSED MEETING

A. PUB20-107 - Deliberate regarding Real Property - Under Texas Government Code Section 551.072; Consultation with Attorneys - Under Texas Government Code Section 551.071.

Discuss, deliberate, receive information from staff, and provide staff with direction pertaining to the potential purchase of real property located southeast of the corner of Thomas J. Egan Rd. and Jim Christal Rd. in Denton, Denton County, Texas ("Property"), where the deliberation of same in an open meeting would have a detrimental effect on the position of the governmental body in negotiations with a third person or potential litigation. Consultation with the City's attorneys regarding legal issues associated with potential claims against the City associated with the Property, where a public discussion of these legal matters would conflict with the duty of the City's attorneys to the City of Denton and the Denton City Council under the Texas Disciplinary Rules of Professional Conduct of the State Bar of Texas, or would jeopardize the City's legal position in negotiations or potential litigation.
